Mission Statement

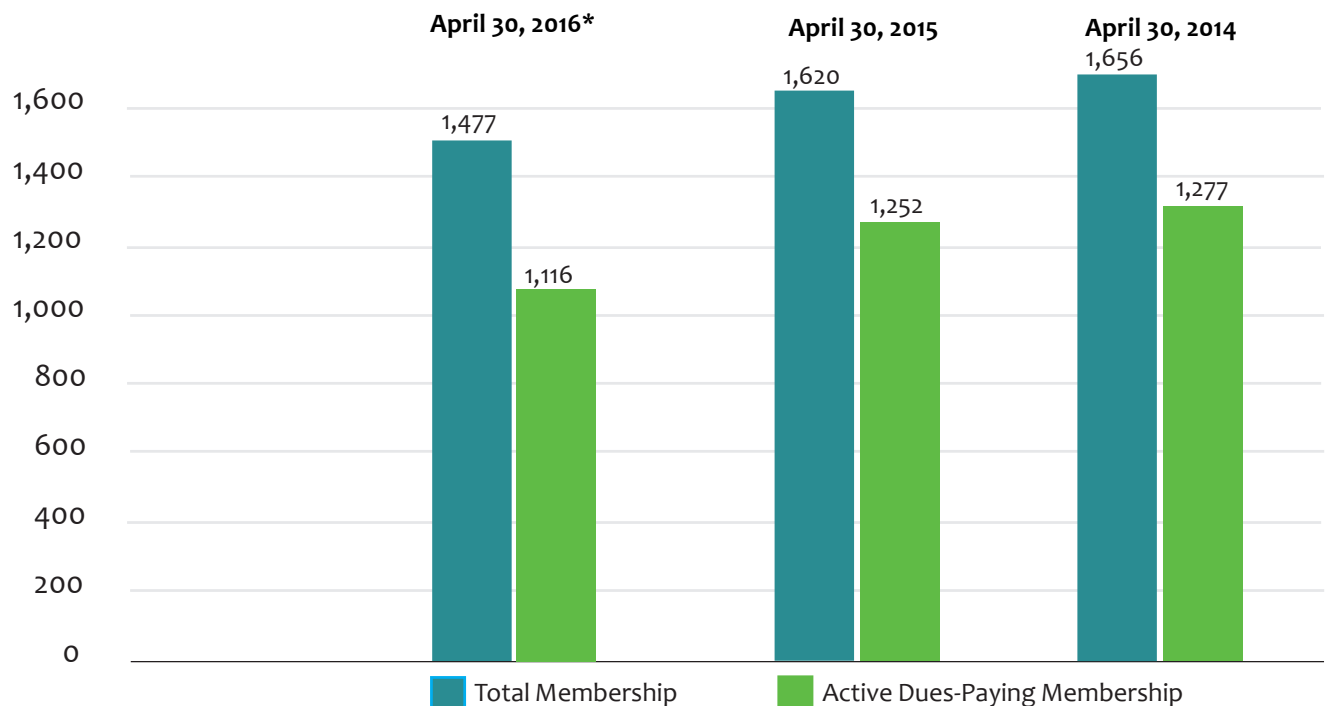
Montgomery County Medical Society's mission is to be the foremost physician organization to advocate for and serve physicians, their medical practices and their patients in Montgomery County, Maryland.

Highlights

1,000+ phone calls from members/medical practice staff requesting answers to complex medical practice questions and challenges.

27 ICD-10 Training Sessions attended by more than 400 physicians and staff.

5 CME programs attended by 262 physicians on topics including HIPAA, Opioid Abuse Prevention, Medical Marijuana, and OSHA.

7 Practice Management updates with 134 physicians and practice managers in attendance.

Formation of **3 new Task Forces** - Aid in Dying to educate and evaluate physician opinions about the proposed End-of-Life Option Act, Physician Well-being Taskforce to address physician burnout, and Hospital-Based/Community Physician Communications.

First-ever **Baseline Practice Survey** completed with 18% response rate providing useful information regarding practice use of EMR, CRISP and other medical practice issues.

2 all-member networking socials at two MoCo restaurants assisting 73 physicians develop new referral sources and build their patient base.

4 educational conferences with 163 members in attendance learning about opioid prescribing, retainer based medicine, payor and compliance updates, and how to best market a medical practice.

3 General Membership Meetings with more than 350 members attending, networking and becoming informed about key issues impacting the practice of medicine. Topics included medical practice options, End-of-Life Act, and the annual installation of officers.

1,200+ member names printed in July-August *Bethesda Magazine* two-page spread. Being repeated in 2016.

128 members recruited between 4/15 and 4/16 (113 physicians; 15 practice staff).

2 Young Physician and Women In Medicine events attended by more than 150 physicians, including MEDTalks and Women in Medicine Red Dress Event at Ann Taylor.

10 Delegates and 2 State Senators from Montgomery County legislative delegation visited MCMS headquarters to meet with members of the Executive Board and Legislative Committee for the annual Legislative Breakfast to discuss hot topics like the rising cost of generic medications.

In conjunction with AMA's National Advocacy Conference, **10 MoCo physicians participated in MedChi delegation visits** to Maryland's Congressional delegation on Capitol Hill to discuss EHR, interoperability issues, payment for telemedicine and ways to address the opioid crisis.

19 physicians visited Maryland's Delegates and State Senators in Annapolis to discuss Medicaid Funding, Board of Physician License Fees, Medical Liability Reform, Patient Safety Intervention Programs, and Virtual Credit Card Fees.

4 issues of Maryland Medicine produced requiring 4 Editorial Board meetings, and draft after draft of editorial content before going to press.

2 MedChi House of Delegates meetings with all 25 delegate seats filled.

80 winter clothing items collected for Interfaith Works and 90 pounds of canned goods collected for Manna Food Center.

Enhanced social media presence with a 54% increase in Twitter follows, 27% increase in Facebook page likes, and established YouTube and LinkedIn presence.

16 Corporate Partners providing valuable services and programs for our members.

52 editions of weekly ENews keeping members informed of deadlines, hot topics and news about practice trends.

Created 2 videos focused on membership retention and recruitment.
